Before You Arrive:

- Food Pickup and Deliveries:
 - Groceries Brookshires in Pittsburg offers curbside pickup. You can build your order online before you arrive, and pick-up groceries on the way. Select Store #46 here: Brookshire's Curbside Stores | Brookshire's Food & Pharmacy. The store is about 10 minutes from the house.
 - Meal Kits We have had guests use Hello Fresh successfully for meal kit delivery to the house. Considering lead times, suggest ordering before you arrive.

Upon Arrival: Where to find house keys, and combination lock codes:

The house key is located in a hide-a-key box to the right of the front door, just on the other side of the gate to the left (right below the gate latch). The combination is: "0325". This key works on all house doors.

All other combination locks (e.g. under the house where the outdoor equipment is stored, and the storage box on the boat house where



seat cushions and catfish food are stored) code is "0325".

Access to the Boathouse shed (for power, fishing poles) is press "Schlage", then "03259". Turn deadbolt counterclockwise. To lock – just press "Schlage" and turn clockwise.

During Your Stay:

- Internet the Network is b_getaway. The password is: Axel2009.
 - If for some reason the internet goes out, the main power (gateway controller and router) are in the laundry room (shelf above the washing machine). Simply turn off (unplug) the power (for a minute), then back on at the surge protector.

- DO <u>NOT</u> 'RESET' THE ROUTER, there is a \$65 service fee for a technician to come to the house to fix router SSID and Password resets.
- Water this home is on well water. All indoor water is filtered (including the fridge) and filters are changed regularly.
 - We also have a fresh Spring Water (hot/cold) dispenser available for guests if you choose (extra 5 gal bottles are in the pantry).
- Power this home is 100% electric. We have updated all lighting to LED to do our part to be 'green'.
 - \circ $\,$ The fire table and outdoor grill have their own propane tanks.
- Kitchen you should find everything you need here regarding tableware, appliances, cooking utensils (indoor and outdoor grilling), pots, pans, serving bowls, trays. We also have some basic seasonings, and condiments in the fridge for your use.
 - Cooking Appliances: Stove, Double Oven, Microwave, 4 Slice Toaster, Coffee
 Makers (drip brew and K-Cups), Blender, Juicer, Rice Cooker, Instapot
 - Please let us know if we missed anything!
- o Bedding & Towels you will find plenty of clean extra linens,

pillows and blankets and towels in all bedroom closets / dresser drawers.

 \circ $\,$ There are extra towels in the Master Bath and walk-in closet

- Sauna The remote control (light therapy) is in the drawer of the coffee table in the game room. The sauna controls are on the left-hand side of the unit (also inside the unit).
- Media & Tech There are three Roku TVs (streaming only), a connected DVD player and blue tooth enabled surround sound system upstairs in living room. There are HDMI ports for those that have brought along their own gaming systems. In the first drawer of the media cabinet you will also find some DVDs for both children and families to enjoy.
 - Note: There are also USB Ports in the upstairs bedrooms via three alarm clocks with 2 USB ports each (6 USB ports) for charging your devices.
- Thermostat (Heat and AC) is located in the hallway. Please feel free to adjust to your own preferences.
- Spotting Scope we have provided for you to enjoy (wildlife watching, water activity, even star gazing). It should only be used by adults, or under adult supervision please.
 - Outdoor Equipment is located under the house in the back. On the wall – you will find two kayaks for guest use! Inside the storage area you will find oars, life vests, axes, yard games, and an umbrella for the boat house table, plus

outdoor chairs for the firepit. There are also extra propane tanks if needed for the outdoor grill and fire table.

- Watercraft Moorage The powerlift / slip on the boathouse is for your use. You are also welcome to tie your own watercraft to any part of the dock, or just beach it up to the shore.
- Fishing Tips we have done great right off the dock. Mostly Bass and Catfish. Crankbait is a favorite for Bass from the dock. Texas Rigs also work well. Catfish are also plentiful, and simply require a treble hook with some chicken liver bait. Add a bobber, and you can just sit back and relax. Of course, the time of year plays a big role in success for both as it is slowest in the winter months. You'll need a boat or kayak and a good depth finder for Crappie fishing, but they are plentiful here too, especially around the bridge piers. There are 4 rods under the house for your use.
- Feed the Fish if you're not into catching them, you can certainly enjoy watching them! You can find catfish feed in the storage box in the boat house storage box. Just toss in a couple handfuls on the side facing the house and enjoy the show.

Safety Tips:

- There are smoke and CO2 detectors on both floors
- There is a fire extinguisher in the hallway closet
- Direct access to the lake: <u>please</u> keep a close eye on small children or pets at all times, especially when in the backyard
- Sauna: please do not allow small children into the sauna when heat is on. Adults should not use if they have consumed alcohol.
- Wood Stove: be sure to open the vent before starting a fire
- Grassy Areas: please be careful when walking on the grass after heavy rain as the property is on clay soil and can be very slippery when wet.
- Shed: This is where the main electrical breaker box is located.
 There is a separate key above the door.
- Nature / Wildlife: This property is in Sunset Bay, a lakeside neighborhood. So, you're not in the middle of nowhere, but please keep in mind that this is still a remote, wilderness area.
 - Deer, raccoons, foxes, coyotes, hawks, pelicans, song birds, hummingbirds, turtles, frogs, woodpeckers, jays, and so much more are regular visitors here.

House Rules:

- Please <u>no smoking</u> nor vaping indoors
- Please no loud music or outdoor sounds <u>after 9:00pm</u> (let's not scare the animals late at night ;)
- Please <u>remove all trash upon departure</u> (there are garbage bags under the sink in the kitchen, use as many as you like).
 - We have weekly trash service so just toss everything in the large outdoor trash can, and wheel up to the curb Sunday night (Monday pick-up), or when you depart.
- Pets We love pets! But please <u>keep pets off all furniture</u> (sofas, chairs, beds) or at least toss a blanket or cover them to keep pet hair and such off to more easily clean, wash.
- This home is on a septic system. Please <u>do not flush wipes</u> or anything other than the paper provided in the bathrooms.
- Please <u>turn off back deck lights</u> before going to bed. Locals like to enjoy star gazing in the evenings (and you can / should too)!
- Please <u>place all used bedding, towels</u>, etc. in the laundry room before departure (we'll take care of it from there)

- Please <u>reattach</u> all outdoor furniture covers, tie-downs and return any equipment, cushions, umbrellas used to their storage places (it can get windy here at times)
- Please place any <u>dirty dishes</u> in the dishwasher and start the machine before departure (we'll put them away)


