Before You Arrive:

- Food Pickup and Deliveries:

During Your Stay:

- Water – this home is on well water. All indoor water is filtered (including the fridge) and all filters are changed regularly.
- Power – this home is 100% electric. We have updated all lighting to LED to do our part to be 'green'.
 - The fire table and outdoor grill have their own propane tanks.

- Kitchen – you should find everything you need here regarding tableware, appliances, cooking utensils (indoor and outdoor grilling), pots, pans, serving bowls, trays. We also have some basic seasonings, and condiments for your use.
 - Cooking Appliances: Stove, Double Oven, Microwave, 4 Slice Toaster, Coffee Maker (drip brew and Kerig), Blender, Juicer, Rice Cooker, Instapot, Electric Griddle
 - Please let us know if we missed anything!
- Bedding & Towels – you will find plenty of clean extra linens, pillows and blankets and towels in all bedroom closets / dresser drawers.
 - There are extra towels in the Master Bath and walk-in closet
- Media & Tech – There are three Roku TVs (streaming only), a connected DVD player and blue tooth enabled surround sound system upstairs (+ TVs in Main bedroom and Game Room downstairs). There are HDMI ports for those that have brought along their own gaming systems. In the first drawer of the media cabinet you will also find some DVDs for both children and families to enjoy.
 - Note: There are also USB Ports in the upstairs bedrooms – via three alarm clocks with 2 USB ports each (6 USB ports) for charging your devices.

- Thermostat – (Heat and AC) is located in the hallway. Please feel free to adjust to your own preferences.
- Spotting Scope – we have provided for you to enjoy (wildlife watching, water activity, even star gazing). It should only be used by adults, or under adult supervision please.
- Outdoor Equipment – is located under the house in the back. On the wall you will find two kayaks! Inside, you will find kayak oars, life vests, axes, yard games, outdoor chairs for the fire pit, and an umbrella for the boat house table.
 - There is also an extra tanks of propane for the outdoor grill or fire table.
- Watercraft Moorage – The powerlift / slip on the boathouse is for your use. You are also welcome to tie your own watercraft to any part of the dock, or just beach it up to the shore.
- Fishing Tips – we have done great right off the dock. Mostly Bass and Catfish. Crankbait is a favorite for Bass from the dock. Texas Rigs also work well. Catfish are also plentiful, and simply require a treble hook with some chicken liver bait. Add a bobber, and you can just sit back and relax. Of course, the time of year plays a big role in success for both as it is slowest in the winter months.

You'll need a boat or kayak and a good depth finder for Crappie fishing, but they are plentiful here too, especially around the bridge piers.

- Feed the Fish – if you're not into catching them, you can certainly enjoy watching them! You can find catfish feed in the storage box in the boat house storage box. Just toss in a couple handfuls on the side facing the house and enjoy the show.

Safety Tips:

- There are smoke and CO2 detectors on both floors
- There is a fire extinguisher in the hallway closet
- Direct access to the lake: please keep a close eye on small children or pets at all times, especially when in the backyard
- Wood Stove: be sure to open the vent before starting a fire
- Grassy Areas: please be careful when walking on the grass after heavy rain as the property is on clay soil and can be very slippery when wet.
- Shed: This is where the main electrical breaker box is located.

- Nature / Wildlife: This property is in Sunset Bay, a lakeside neighborhood. So, you're not in the middle of nowhere, but please keep in mind that this is still a remote, wilderness area.
 - Deer, raccoons, foxes, coyotes, hawks, eagles, pelicans, songbirds, hummingbirds, woodpeckers, jays, and so much more are regular visitors here.

House Rules:

- Please no smoking nor vaping indoors
- Please no loud music or outdoor sounds after 9:00pm (let's not scare the animals late at night ;)
- Please **remove all trash upon departure** (there are garbage bags under the sink in the kitchen, use as many as you like).
 - We have added weekly trash service – so just toss everything in the large outdoor trash can, and **wheel up to the curb Sunday** night (Monday pick-up), **or whenever you leave.**
- Pets – We love pets! But please keep pets off all furniture (sofas, chairs, beds) – or at least toss a blanket or cover them to keep pet hair and such off to more easily clean, wash.
- This home is on a septic system. Please do not flush wipes or anything other than the paper provided in the bathrooms.

- Please turn off back deck lights before going to bed. Locals like to enjoy star gazing in the evenings (and you can / should too)!
- Please place all used bedding, towels, etc. in the laundry room before departure (we'll take care of it from there)
- Please reattach all outdoor furniture covers, tie-downs and return any equipment, cushions, umbrellas used to their storage places (it can get windy here at times)
- Please place any dirty dishes in the dishwasher and start the machine before departure (we'll put them away)

Dining Out, Restaurants (local favorites):


- Pittsburg:
 - **Castaway's** – Located adjacent to Big Al's Barefoot Bay Marina. The 'newest' local hot spot, serving typical American cuisine, full bar, seasonal live entertainment, pool tables.

- **Papa Nachos** - Excellent service, open 7 days a week, late hours on weekends, clean, family friendly, quality Tex-Mex cuisine, full bar.
 - **Pittsburg Hot Links** – great place for lunch, local favorite and ‘famous’ for their links, traditional Southern Comfort Food.
 - **Daysi's Y Mariscos Taqueria** – authentic Mexican street food in a not too fancy spot, service can be slow, but the food is very authentic. Suggest considering call-in ordering.
 - **Peralta's Italian** - Traditional Italian Food option. Good food, service, and nice sit-down dining ambiance.
 - **IHOP** – brand new location, clean, good service, good place for breakfast or even lunch. Also, can pick up basic supplies, snacks, fuel (adjoining Stacy's convenience store and gas station). Usually open early / late – when most of Pittsburg restaurants are closed.
- Mt. Pleasant:
 - Much larger variety of the usual fast / casual chains (Panda Express, Chillis, Arby's, Scholtzky's, Braum's, Dairy Queen, WhataBurger, etc.) and many more local dining options.
